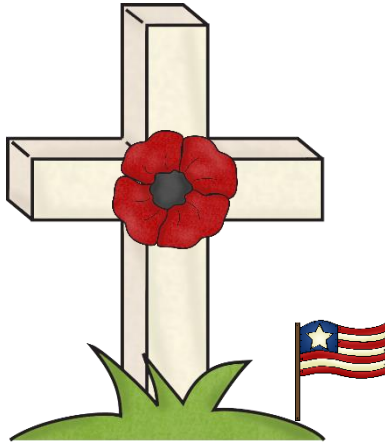

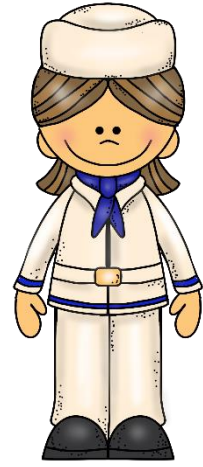




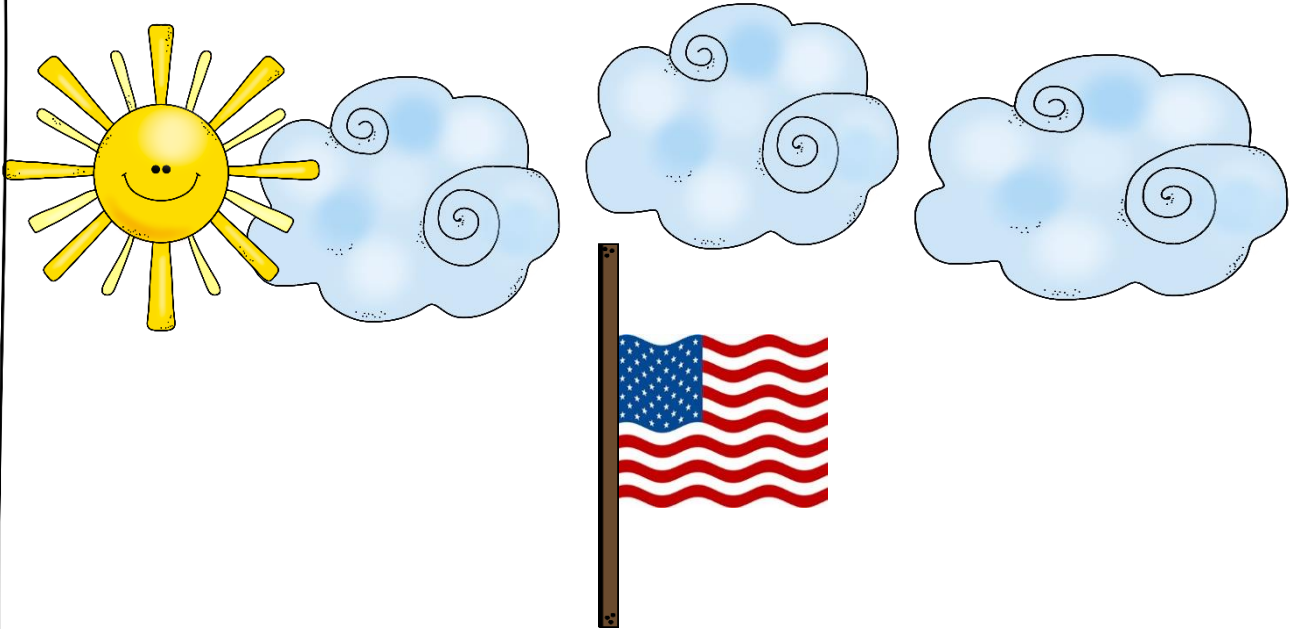
Memorial Day is a national holiday in the United States.



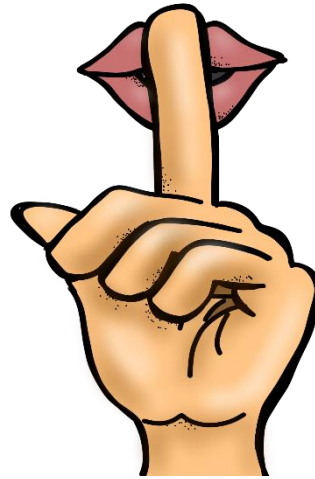
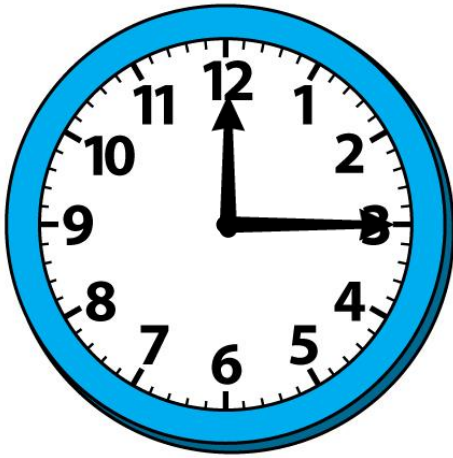
Memorial Day is celebrated in May every year.



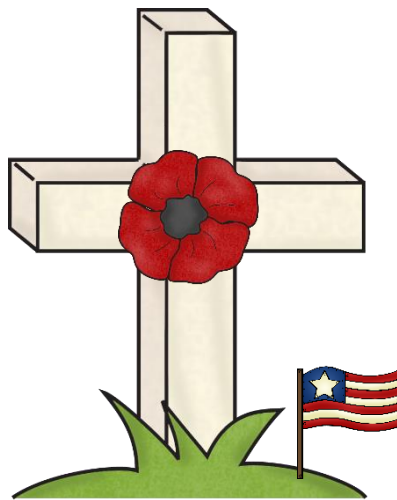
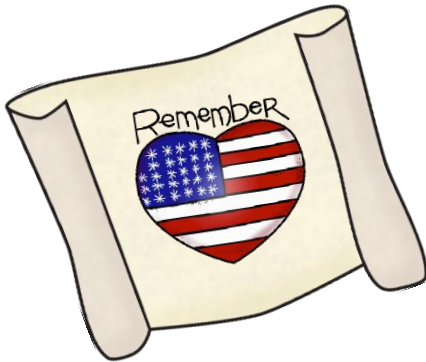
We honor soldiers from wars throughout history who have died while fighting for their country on this day.



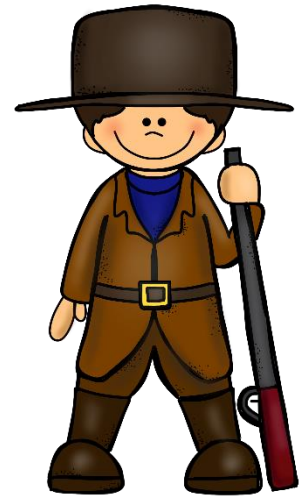
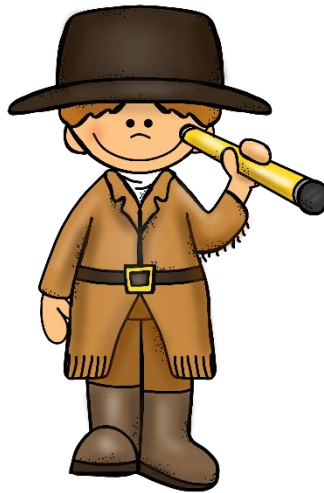
We fly the American flag at half mast from dawn until midday on Memorial Day.



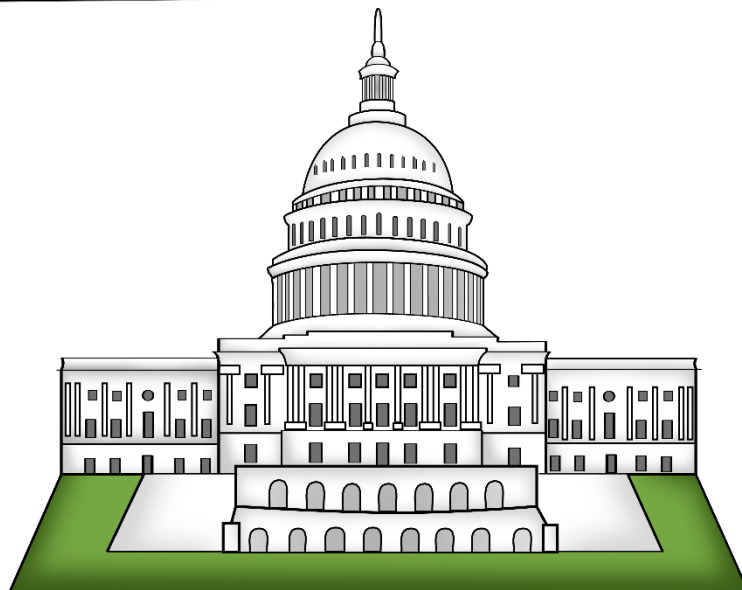
At 3:00 p.m. it is a tradition to have a moment of silence in honor of those who have died serving their country.



The President makes a speech and places a wreath on the tomb of the unknown soldiers in Arlington National Cemetery.



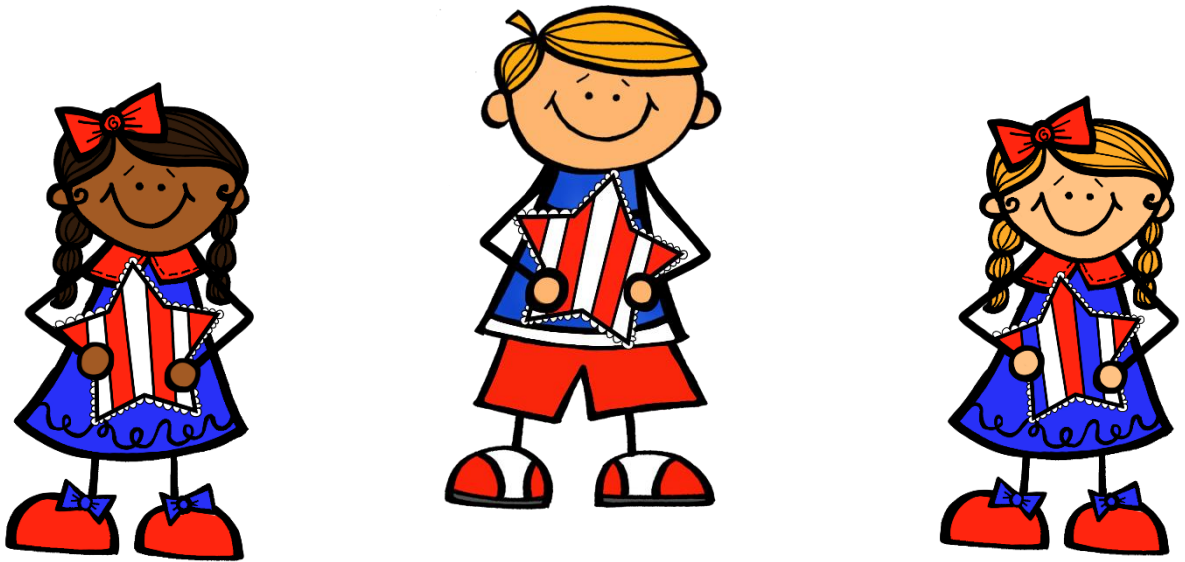
Memorial Day began after the Civil War and it was originally called "Decoration Day".

Many people have sacrificed and died so that we can live in a free country.



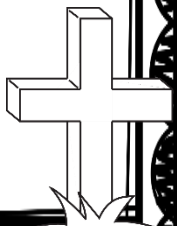
We should honor and give thanks to all who have served in the military in order for us to have our freedom.
