








It rained the next day, too.

"We are sick of tents and dressing up," said Pig and Cat.






"This will be fun for Pig," said Nell.

The next day, Nell heard clanging. She heard banging. "Nell, come quick!" called Dog.






Nell got in.

Thump Thump liked to thump.


He thumped a lot as he sang.
